Fun with Fashion and Clover Collection



This is an opportunity for youth to model/showcase clothing or items they have purchased or constructed. It's a fashion show open to all 4-H Club members in all projects, particularly Clothing & Textiles, Consumer Education, Creative Arts & Design, Performing Arts, and Personal Development

Both events are open to youth (boys and girls) grades 4-12. (Grade as of Jan. 1 of the current year) Youth participate as individuals and can participate in both Fun with Fashion and Clover Collection contests.

Fun with Fashion is a contest where 4-H members model outfits they have purchased and assembled based on a situation and budget. Participants are judged on their consumer skills and ability to select appropriate clothing for their body and situation.

Premium Schedule: First place: \$12, Second place: \$9, Third place: \$7

Fun with Fashion Rules

1. The Fun with Fashion event provides practice in consumer purchasing skills.
2. The majority of the outfit, including accessories, is to be purchased using the scenario and budget provided. Shoes do not need to be new or counted in the budget.
3. The cost of the outfit and accessories will be recorded.
4. Judging is based on the coordination and selection of an ensemble as appropriate for the provided scenario and budget.
5. Accessories are chosen, and the appearance of the outfit on the individual, and modeling ability will also be considered.
6. No changes will be made on the day of the show. No additions will be added after registration closes.

The Fun with Fashion event provides practice in consumer purchasing skills. Each participant may choose up to three classes to enter. The majority of the outfit(s) including accessories, is to be purchased with the scenario and budget in mind. Shoes do not need to be new or counted in the budget. Remember to use comparison shopping to check prices for the same or similar outfits in different stores. You may use second-hand stores such as thrift or consignment stores, or even yard sales! Keep up with your costs and savings. These will be recorded on the Fun with Fashion personal data sheet that will be submitted to your agent by the deadline provided. Receipts do not need to be submitted.

Clover Collection is a contest where 4-H members enter garments, outfits, or items they have constructed. Participants will enter the items to be judged on construction and will then model their items in a fashion show.

Premiums: First place: \$12, Second place: \$9, Third place: \$7

Rules:

1. Participants must be active 4-H members. Contact your TN Extension County 4-H Agent

to register.

2. 4-H members must sew their entire ensemble except for class 1. In this class, the top may be purchased.
3. 4-H members may enter one garment/ensemble in each category for which their experience and grade level are included. 4-H members entering the beginning sewing categories should have less than two years of sewing experience.
4. Pre-registration is required. 4-H members must submit a separate form for each entry.
5. Judging will be completed before modeling on stage.

Class 1: Beginning Sewing grades 4 & 5 - Elastic Waist Garment: skirt, pants, or shorts with elastic in the waistband

Class 2: Beginning Sewing grades 6-12 – Complete ensemble which includes pants or shorts and skirt, and top, simple dress, etc.

Class 3: School Wear grades 4-7- Complete ensemble which includes pants, skirt, jeans, khakis, capri pants, or knee-length shorts with shirts or tops, or a casual dress, etc.

Class 4: Best Wear grades 4-7 - Complete ensemble which includes a nicer dress, suit, or other dressy coordinating pieces

Class 5: School Wear grades 8-12 – Complete ensemble which includes pants, skirt, jeans, khakis, capri pants, or knee-length shorts with shirts or tops, or a casual dress, etc.

Class 6: Best Wear grades 8-12- Complete ensemble which includes a nicer dress, suit, or other dressy coordinating pieces

Class 7 – Formalwear grades 8-12- Formal(long) or semi-formal (shorter lengths) prom-type or party dresses or formal suits.

Class 8: Accessory grades 4-12 – Any sewn accessory including belt,scarf, purse, wallet, backpack, travel kit or bag, headband, hat, tie or bowtie, apron, or other

Class 9: Costume grades 4-12 - Any garments considered a historic costume, cosplay ensemble, or another costume.

Class 10: Upcycled Garment grades 4-12- This category includes “New” garments created by significantly altering original garments or other fabric items. Sewing by machine or hand must be part of the alteration process, but other techniques may also be included.

Each participant will choose classes based on their grade as of January 1 of the current year. 4-H members may enter one garment or ensemble in each class for which their experience and grade level are included. 4-H members entering the beginning sewing categories should have less than two years of sewing experience.
