For over 100 years, 4-H has welcomed young people of all backgrounds and beliefs by giving them a voice to express who they are and how they can improve their lives and communities. 4-H prepares young people for a successful future through educational programs emphasizing life skills. An experiential learning model fosters critical thinking, social skills, communication, citizenship, and leadership. 4-H is the youth development program of The University of Tennessee and Tennessee State University. UT/TSU are two of more than 100 public universities nationwide, offering experiences that enable young people to learn by doing. In-school 4-H clubs are available at every school.


